

## TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Family!

In the Gospel, Jesus' words could have caused havoc to the people who read the Bible in English when he said, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple."

God's Word, Jesus takes root in us from the beginning to the end of our life on earth to bring us life and that life in fullness. Semitic languages do not have a word for 'prefer'. "When a person prefers one thing over another, that person is said to 'love' that thing and 'hate' the other." (Geoffrey Plant). Jesus' preaching is not about hate but Jesus must have first place if one wishes to follow Him.

Looking at the large crowd following Jesus, this message is very powerful and contextual when Jesus teaches about the cost of discipleship. The three areas to address in the gospel are 1. Putting God above family 2. Bearing one's cross and 3. Leaving it all. We witness the Apostles grow into some of these commitments as time passed. In the same way we continue to grow into these commitments as individuals and as a community.

# Pope Leo Canonized Pier Giorgio Frassati and Carlo Acutis this Sunday.

Pope Francis had announced the canonization of these two young men at the General Audience of 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2024. Seven more will be canonized in October. 1. Martyred Armenian Catholic Archbishop Ignatius Shoukrallah Maloyan, 2. Peter To Rot, a lay catechist, a martyr - will be the first saint from Papua New Guinea, 3. Vincenza Maria Poloni, founder of the Sisters of Mercy in Verona; 4. Maria del Monte Carmelo Rendiles, founder of the Servents of Jesus; 5. Maria Troncatti, of the Daughters of Mary, Help of Christians; 6. Bartolo Longo, founder of Marian Shrine at Pompeii and 7. Jose Gregorio Hernandez Cisneros, member of a Secular Franciscan Order.

# **Sept 8 Mon - Feast of The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

#### The birth of Immaculate Humility

"The devil likes... pride... because it is the principle and source of all sin. On the other hand, it displeases God just as much as it pleases the devil. God is displeased by pride and pleased by humility. "God was so pleased with Mary's humility that his goodness compelled him to give her the Word, his Only Begotten Son - and she was the wonderful Mother who gave (that Word) to us. You know well that God's Son did not take flesh within Mary until she had clearly expressed both her will and her humility by saying, Ecce ancilla Domini. Let it be done to me according to your Word. But as soon as she had said this, she conceived within her the dear spotless Lamb. By this, gentle First Truth was showing us how excellent this little virtue is, and how much those receive who in humility give their will as an offering to their Creator. "So in times of difficulty; when we are harassed or hurt, slandered or vilified by our neighbors; when we are troubled in mind or deprived of spiritual or temporal consolation by Creator or creature (by our Creator in kindness, when he draws our spiritual feelings back into himself (through it seems from the severity of our pain and struggles that he is no longer within us); and by other people when it seems from our conversation and recreation with them that we love them more than they love us) – in all these things, I tell you, those who have been made perfect in humility say,

"My Lord, here I am, your maidservant! Let it be done in me according to your will, and not according to what my emotions want." In this way they give off the perfume of patience – to the Creator and to other people and to themselves. The enjoy spiritual peace and calm. In the midst of war, they have found peace because they have rid themselves of selfish willfulness grounded in pride." (Saint Catherine of Siena, +1380 A.D).

#### **DEACON'S CORNER**

This Gospel is a radical invitation to true discipleship. Jesus is not discouraging love for family or the enjoyment of life's blessings, but He is teaching that God must be the absolute priority.

Discipleship is costly: Following Christ is not simply about admiration or convenience. It demands sacrifice, commitment, and sometimes letting go of comforts, possessions, or even relationships when they become obstacles to faith.

Carrying the cross: To follow Jesus is to accept suffering and challenges with faith, knowing that the cross is not the end, but the path to resurrection and life.

Counting the cost: Just as someone building a tower or going to war plans carefully, the Christian is called to reflect seriously: Am I ready to follow Jesus not only in blessings but also in trials?

True freedom: By renouncing everything for Christ, paradoxically, we gain the fullness of life and freedom. Nothing can enslave us if Christ is first.





En el Evangelio, las palabras de Jesús podrían haber causado estragos en las personas que leen la Biblia en inglés cuando dijo: "Si alguno viene a mí y no aborrece a su padre y madre, mujer e hijos, hermanos y hermanas, e incluso su propia vida, no puede ser mi discípulo".

La Palabra de Dios, Jesús, se arraiga en nosotros desde el principio hasta el fin de nuestra vida terrenal para darnos vida, y esa vida en plenitud. Las lenguas semíticas no tienen una palabra para «preferir». «Cuando una persona prefiere una cosa sobre otra, se dice que esa persona la ama y la odia». (Geoffrey Plant). 


