CHRISTIAN CHARITY

Attending Mass, prayer, study, and the practice of Christian Charity are important ways in which we open ourselves to receive the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. ***Christian Charity means doing good things for others out of love for Jesus and our neighbors.*** It can mean activities like minding your younger brothers and sisters, glorifying God by singing in the SPSJ Youth Choir, helping the elderly, neighbors, or parents with outdoor chores; or serving the poor at a soup kitchen, and being an altar server. As long as you accept no pay for your work and do it in a spirit of Christ like love, it counts as Christian Charity.

Since such charity helps us grow as Christians and opens our hearts more fully to receive God's grace, you are required to do such acts of charity as you prepare for Confirmation. While our pastor is not too concerned with exact hours, he asks that you try to perform about 10 hours of Christian Charity as part of your Confirmation preparation. ***It would be best if you perform at least a few hours of several different kinds of Christian Charity.***
